Pursuant to an order from the Surveyor General of Florida, and in conformity with Report No. 1 claim 136, by the Commissioners of East Florida, and confirmed by an act of Congress passed the 5<sup>th</sup> February 1827.

We have surveyed, measured & marked the boundaries of a tract of land claimed by Francis Pellicier lying on the West margin of the Matanzas river and at the mouth of Pellicier creek, being Sec 39 of Township 10 Range 30 E East and is bounded thus Beginning at a pine tree at the West margin of the Matanzas river or the mouth of this river marked A. P. an original corner thence S 11° 17' 33" W 77 ch. to B. thence N 40° W 141 ch. to C, thence N 01° E 247 ch. to D. at the South margin of Pellicier creek thence down the same as follows to A beginning corner at A containing One thousand one hundred and four acres and forty eight hundredths of an acre, and having such shape form and number as here above represented.
