**Case:** 10K White Gold Filled Case - 30 mm across and 37 mm lug to lug. The Screw on back case cover has an outer ring and is marked: Bulova, 10 KT GF Case, Shock Resistant, J476563, M7, Anti-Magnetic, Water Proof, Self-Winding

**Dial:** Simply stunning - Silver background - Marked Bulova, 30 Jewels, and Self Winding. Features 4 diamonds at the 2, 4, 8 and 10 o'clock positions. Arabic numerals at the 12, 6 and 9 o'clock positions. A date window at the 3 o'clock position. The hours and minute hands are silver in color and the sweeping seconds hand is sleek in design and silver colored.

**Movement:** 30 Jewels Self Winding. Marked Bulova U.S.A., 30 Jewels, 10C0ACD and M7.

**Band/Strap:** Brand new 16 mm Black Colored Lizard Style Genuine Leather with a gold toned buckle.

**Comments:** In 1911, Joseph Bulova, an immigrant from Czechoslovakia, founded the Bulova Watch Company. Then, in 1920, Bulova moved to 580 Fifth Avenue in New York City where it built the Bulova Observatory (the world's first atop a skyscraper.) During its long and successful history, the Bulova Company would achieve fame in the watch and clock making industry which included the development of the Accutron (the first fully electronic watch.) Today, the company remains headquartered in New York and they are once again producing stylish and innovative watches from plants located in Switzerland.

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
